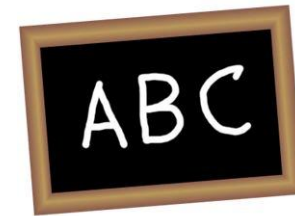

PRAXIS II TESTS

Utah State University Content Tests – Utah Level 1 Licensure

ETS charges a \$50.00 registration fee (charged once per testing year). This is in addition to the cost of each exam

Testing Schedule: 1 - Session 1 (7:30 - 10:30 am)
 2 - Session 2 (10:45 am - 1:30 pm)
 3 - Session 3 (2:15 - 5:00 pm)

Cut off Score: Scores without “#” is Utah Cut-Off Score – Students who score the Utah cut-off score or higher, will receive No Child Left Behind (NCLB) “highly qualified status”

Scores with “#” denotes the National Median Score (This is a temporary Utah cut-off score) – Students who score the National Median score or higher will receive NCLB “highly qualified status;” Students who score below the National Median - NCLB highly qualified status will be “pending” until Utah cut-off score is established. Students are NOT encouraged to retake any exams until a Utah cut-off score is established.
